Biographical Note

Chester Clark Spring (1878 – 1957) was a founding member of the Wellesley Historical Society, serving as its Vice-President from its founding in 1925 to 1935, when he took over as President. He served in this capacity until 1942, when the society went dormant for over a decade due to World War II. He married Edna Pauline Sharpe Crane on June 21, 1919 at St. Mary's Episcopal Church, Newton Lower Falls.

Chester C. Spring was the son of Charles H. Spring (1854 –) and Annie J. (Clark) Spring, of Wellesley; his grandfather was George Spring (1821-1896), born in Weston, resided in Wellesley. The Spring family was active with St. Mary's Episcopal Church, Newton Lower Falls, for generations.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains materials belonging to the Spring family. Of particular note is the collection of stamped envelopes featuring Grantville and Wellesley addresses and postmarks.
