Biographical Note

Henry Bowen Brainerd was born in Wellesley on December 8, 1907 to parents William H. Brainerd and Mary Bowen Brainerd. William Brainerd was a Boston-area architect who designed several Wellesley homes including his own at 10 Upland Road, and Katharine Lee Bates' home at 70 Curve Street. Mary Bowen Brainerd taught in the English Literature Department at Wellesley College for ten years before marrying.

Henry Brainerd attended the Huntington School on Huntington Avenue in Boston before attending Harvard University where he graduated with a BA in Physics in 1927. Due to the Depression, Brainerd's first jobs out of college included working in sales for the Wellesley Press as well as free-lance photography work. During World War II Brainerd did electronic development work at Camp Evens in Belmont, New Jersey.

In 1943 Brainerd married Nanette Tarbox Beals in New York before returning to Massachusetts in 1946, taking up residence in Brainerd's childhood home, located at 10 Upland Road in Wellesley, MA. Brainerd worked at Massachusetts Institute of Technology's (MIT) Draper Lab from 1946 until he retired in 1973. Brainerd was an active member of the Wellesley community until his death on September 24, 1995.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains materials related to the life of Henry Bowen Brainerd and his life in Wellesley. The collection contains correspondence, written materials, and photography. Of note are the written recollections and oral history interview regarding life in Wellesley from 1907 until the 1980s. The bulk of the collection is made of the photographic negatives and prints produced by Brainerd throughout his life as an amateur photographer.
