Biographical Note

The Boston & Worcester Railroad Corporation (B&W) was incorporated in 1831; construction reached Wellesley by 1834, and the complete single-track line to Worcester was fully operational in 1835. By 1843 the entire length was two-way double-tracked. The B&W was the first steampowered railroad to operate in New England.

The Boston & Albany Railroad Co. (B&A) was the result of a merger between several railroad companies, including the B&W. By 1870 the mergers were complete, and rail service extended from Albany to Boston, encompassing the line from Worcester to Boston, which included the Wellesley stops in Wellesley Square, Wellesley Hills, and Wellesley Farms, and Newton Lower Falls (the station was technically in Wellesley). The MBTA now manages the line from Worcester to Boston.

Scope and Content Note

This small collection contains several items relation to railroad service in Wellesley in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Folder 1 contains the *ABC Pathfinder Railway Guide* from June 1882; information on the B&A can be found on pages 62-65. Folder 2 contains a pamphlet outlining the 1895 debate in Wellesley regarding fares and frequency of service on the B&A line at a time it was morphing into a commuter railway system. The collection also includes tickets, a cartoon, and a ledger account book.
