Biographical Note

Robert Dana Chellis was born to parents Robert Dunning Chellis and Elizabeth (Colp) Chellis on February 7, 1937. The Chellis family moved from Weston, Massachusetts to Wellesley in the 1960s. The family lived at 17 Windemere Road, this house was originally listed at 588 Worcester Street, then given the 17 Windermere Road address in the late 1950s, and changed again to 4 Windemere Lane in the late 1990s. The house itself never physically moved. Chellis continued to live in this house until 2011. Chellis graduated from Noble and Greenough High School in 1955 and attended Princeton University. While at Princeton Chellis participated in the U.S. Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC) and graduated from the university in 1959 as a second lieutenant. Chellis attended U.S. Army Artillery and Missile School in Fort Still, Oklahoma before serving as a first lieutenant in the U.S. Army. After serving in the army, Chellis worked for State Street Bank and Trust Company. Over the course of his career, Chellis served on the Board of Directors for the Carroll Center for the Blind, a Newton, Massachusetts based rehabilitation agency, and as treasurer and director of long range planning of the Elizabeth Carlton House in Boston, Massachusetts. Chellis then established his own consulting firm, Chellis Associates, which specialized in conducting feasibility studies for assisted living and congregate housing.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains materials belonging to Robert Dana Chellis. The bulk of the collection is made up of materials related to Chellis' time spent in the army and course work which he completed through the U.S. Army Artillery and Missile School. The collection also contains a small number of Chellis family photographs and high school diplomas belonging to Robert Dunning Chellis and his first wife Edith May Brooks Hill.
