## **Biographical Note**

The Fuller family's connection with Wellesley predates Wellesley's incorporation in 1881. Thomas Fuller was one of the original owners of land in the area of Dedham and Needham that now makes up Wellesley Hills. The Fuller land is located in the area of Seaver Street and Great Plains Avenue. G. Clinton Fuller was a descendent of Thomas Fuller and owned 11 Great Plains Avenue. He was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Edwin Fuller, born in Wellesley in 1868 in what was known as the Moulton House located at the corner of Wellesley Avenue and Seaver Street. The Moulton house would become the lifelong home of G. Clinton's sister Ada Fuller Moulton. G. Clinton Fuller served as superintendent of the Wellesley Post Office for 33 years. He also served for periods of time as the town tax collector and the business manager of the *Townsman*. G. Clinton Fuller died on January 25, 1940 and was buried in Woodlawn Cemetery. He was survived by his sister Ada Fuller Moulton and daughter Katherine Fuller. Katherine Fuller, a 1927 Wellesley College graduate, owned 11 Great Plains Ave until her marriage to Merritt Raymond Langdell on July 10, 1945. After their wedding the couple moved to Milford, New Hampshire where Langdell was employed by the Langdell Lumber Company, at which time the Great Plains Avenue property was sold.

## **Scope and Content Note**

This collection contains materials belonging to the Fuller family. Katherine Fuller is the member of the family most directly addressed by the materials in the collection. The collection contains genealogical research, examples of schoolwork, a scrapbook, reading materials, and clippings.
