Biographical Note

John T. "Jack" Griffin was born in Wellesley on January 1, 1901. He was raised on Linden Street, attending Wellesley public schools, and graduated from Dartmouth College in 1923. Following college he returned home to Wellesley were he eventually settled at 68 Linden Street, and served as an active member of the Wellesley community. During the Great Depression, Griffin oversaw the Works Progress Administration (WPA) programs in Wellesley including the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC). From 1933 – 1966, he served as the executive secretary for the Wellesley Board of Selectmen. From 1986 – 1972, after retiring from his role with the Board of Selectmen, he served as the town assessor. In addition to his involvement with the town government he was a member of the Wellesley Club, Wellesley Historical Society, 22 ½ Club, and Kiwanis. Griffin and his wife Rose E. Johnson Griffin had two sons, John T. Griffin Jr. and Robert J. Griffin. John T. Griffin Sr. died on November 24, 1989 and is buried in Woodlawn Cemetery.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains materials related to the life and work of the Griffin family. Materials belonging to John T. Griffin relate to his work in Wellesley during the 1930s and 1940s. Other materials relate to the education of Robert J. Griffin and the taxi service operated by Thomas B. Griffin. Other materials include assorted Griffin family correspondence, clippings and household bills and printed reading materials belonging to the family.
