Biographical Note

George A. Haynes was born in West Newton on October 9, 1898. After graduating from the Newton public school system, he worked for decades as a banker with Newton Cooperative Bank. He married Elizabeth Arnold Haynes, daughter of Carolyn L. Huling, in 1925.

Haynes is best known in Wellesley as an innovator in real estate development, both residential and commercial. In 1929 he purchased 110 acres along Cliff Road from the Clapp estate, developing the Cliff-Abbot Estates through the 1930s; he went on to purchase hundreds more acres in the area for development. In 1939 he built first shopping center in Wellesley with off-street parking, at Wellesley Hills Square, still extant at 260-278 Washington Street, across from the end of Elm Park. Haynes was an advocate for development controls before zoning and subdivision were the norm in Wellesley. George A. Haynes died on January 23, 1980.

His son, G. Arnold Haynes (b.1927), continued the family's real estate development interests in Wellesley with Haynes Management, Inc. starting in 1953; he died on October 15, 2017. Over the decades Haynes Management developed residential and business properties throughout suburban Boston; their corporate offices are located in Wellesley Hills.
