PROVENANCE

The Wellesley Historical Society began collecting Mary Brewster Hazelton portraits in in 1965. These initial acquisitions included portraits of Herbert M. Hazelton, Seldon L. Brown, Ralph Coburn, Mrs. John Oldham, and Margaret Page Hazelton. The portrait collection grew over a period of over twenty years, with significant gifts given to the society in 1986 and 1989. Glass Plate Negatives of several paintings were given to the Society in 1967 (accession #: 1967.74-1967-85).

The bulk of the materials in the Hazelton Family Collection were given to the Society in 1971 (accession #: 1971.28) from Helen Hazelton, a distant relation of the Hazelton Family. She was given the collection by Olivia Bowditch Hazelton. Partial inventories of the Collection were conducted in in 1971 and 1988. While the Mary Brewster Hazelton portraits owned by the Wellesley Historical Society are not considered part of the collection described in this finding aid, information about the paintings may be found in the collection.

EXTENT

The collection consists of 39 Document Cases of Papers, 2 Document Cases of Scrapbooks, 9 Document Cases of Photographic Material (including 2 Document Cases of Glass Plate Negatives), 1 Oversize Box of Daguerreotypists and Tintypes, and 7 Cartons (combined) of Diaries, Sketchbooks, and Notebooks. There are also 3 Cartons and 2 Oversized Boxes of Artifacts, 4 Cartons of Books, 3.5 Oversized Boxes of Artwork, and 2.5 Oversized Boxes of Oversize Printed Material. The Wellesley Historical Society owns 59 Paintings by Mary Brewster Hazelton and 1 Portrait by Isaac Brewster Hazelton, which are not included in this collection.

Oversized Printed Material is found in Boxes 55, 56, and 57. Notebooks, Sketchbooks and Diaries are located in Boxes 58-64. Books are located in Boxes 65-68. Artifacts are located in Boxes 69-73

ARRANGEMENT NOTE

This collection is divided into eight series categorized by individual. The series are as follows: Extended Family Information, Isaac Hills Hazelton and Mary Allen Brewster Hazelton, Isaac Brewster, Hazelton Family, Hazelton Household, Mary Brewster Hazelton, Margaret Page Hazelton, Olivia Bowditch Hazelton.

LANGUAGE NOTE

The material is mainly in English; there is a small amount of correspondence in Italian and French, and Mary Brewster Hazelton made a few notes in noted bound volumes in Italian.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Isaac Hills Hazelton (1838-1929) and Mary Allen Brewster Hazelton (1843-1923) moved to Wellesley in 1873, settling first at 162 Washington Street and then moving to 319 Washington Street with their expanding family in 1884. Their son Isaac Brewster Hazelton (1873-1943) left Wellesley and settled in Nutley, New Jersey to raise a family with Margarita Thompson Hazelton (1882-1972). He became a noted commercial artist under the name I.B. Hazelton. Isaac Brewster Hazelton's child and grandchildren often visited with the rest of the family in Wellesley and at the Hazelton cottage on Isle au Haut in Maine.

Their three daughters Mary Brewster Hazelton (1868-1953), Olivia Bowditch Hazelton (1873-1967), and Margaret Page Hazelton (1876-1965) lived at 319 Washington Street throughout their lives were referred to as the "Misses Hazeltons" by neighbors and acquaintances. Mary Brewster Hazelton became a celebrated Boston portrait artist; Olivia Bowditch Hazelton was a noted expert in Kindergarten Music Education while Margaret Page Hazelton focused on homemaking. Additional biographical information on the various family members can be found in the **Biographical Note** of each series.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The focus of this collection is the personal and professional papers of Mary Brewster Hazelton. A secondary focus is the personal and professional papers of Olivia Bowditch Hazelton. There is also information about the professional career of Dr. Isaac Hills Hazelton and limited information about Isaac Brewster Hazelton and his family. In addition there are papers relating to the lives of Mary Allen Brewster Hazelton and Margaret Page Hazelton. The three sisters lived together for over fifty years and elements of their personal and financial lives were often combined. This finding aid refers to the sisters' household as the Hazelton Household. The small number of Papers relating to other members of the extended Hazelton and Brewster Families can be found in the Extended Family Series.

Correspondence between immediate family members is organized by author. Many extended family members referred to themselves as "Aunt" or "Cousin" in correspondence to Hazelton Family members. It should not be assumed that these self-defined cousins were first cousins of family members or that the various "Aunts" were sisters of the individual's parents.

Generally the series are further divided into correspondence, family correspondence, handwritten notes, literary productions, financial documents, legal documents, printed material, scrapbooks, artwork, photographs, books and artifacts. More information about the arrangement of a particular series can be found in the Arrangement Note for each series.

Information, photographs, and manuscripts obtained during research of the collection by various individuals connected to the Wellesley Historical Society can be found in Appendix C. This appendix also contains unidentified Photographic Material, Prints and Photographs of Mary Brewster Hazelton's paintings that were not necessarily created at the request of the artist. Throughout the finding aid there are references to various paintings by Mary Brewster Hazelton. The titles of these paintings were taken from documents in the collection relating to individual paintings. These titles are not the official titles of the paintings and the same painting may be referred to by multiple titles.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

William Henry Brewster was born in Portsmouth New Hampshire on January 29, 1812. He was the son of Samuel Brewster (died 1833) and Mary Ham Brewster (born 1771) who married on June 26, 1796. William Henry Brewster died on January 1880 in Newburyport, Massachusetts. He married Mary Young Allen Brewster on March 30, 1837. They had at least five children: Mary Allan Brewster Hazelton (1843-1923), Allen Brewster (1840-1942), Margaret Allen Brewster Page (born 1846), Allen Morse Brewster (born 1851), and William Henry Brewster (1848-1904). The children who survived to adulthood all lived in Massachusetts as adults.

Susan Chisholm Pickard Hazelton married to Isaac Hills Hazelton (June 5, 1805-Sept. 8, 1863) in 1835 and born on February 24th 1814. She died in 1912. They had six children: Isaac Hills Hazelton (1838-1929), Clara Louisa Hazelton (1853-1937), Emma C. Hazelton (1850-1887), Frank John Hazelton (1845-1933), Annette Pickard Hazelton Barrett (1836-1921) and Alice C. Hazelton Greene (1857-1938).

Alice Hazelton Green married of Samuel B. Green (1859-1910), a noted horticulturalist. Correspondence between the Hazelton Household and May Hazelton in the Hazelton Household series suggests that Olivia Bowditch Hazelton, Margaret Page Hazelton, and Mary Brewster Hazelton were responsible for the settlement of her estate.

Clara Louisa Hazelton lived in Needham, Massachusetts as an adult.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

Genealogical Information consists of seven folders relating to Hazelton and Brewster Genealogy. It includes an extensively notated pedigree form for Isaac Brewster Hazelton, which is missing page nine and Notes about the Stickney family ancestry. There are also Legal documents relating to land purchases by ancestors between 1773 and 1850, a copy of the

Hazelton Family Crest, and booklets relating to descendants of the Elder William Brewster and the Hills Family Genealogical Association.

Papers of Individual Extended Family Members includes papers relating to the individual extended family members Mary Young Allen Brewster, William Henry Brewster, Alice Hazelton Green, Clara L. Hazelton, and Susan Pickard Hazelton. These papers include the name cards of Mary Young Allen Brewster, and the 1902 change of address notice of William Henry Brewster. A letter from William Henry Brewster can also be found in Mary Brewster Hazelton's series which also contains a copy of his will sent to Mary Brewster Hazelton and information about her role in the settlement of his estate.

The three folders of Alice Hazelton Green's papers contain correspondence sent to her near the end of her life, information about the distribution of her estate and a 1910 memorial booklet about the life of Samuel B. Green. Letters from Alice Hazelton Green to various Hazeltons can be found in the various recipients' series. Photographs sent by Alice Hazelton Green and her husband in letters to Mary Brewster Hazelton can be found in Mary Brewster Hazelton's series.

There is one letter sent from a Hills relation to Clara L. Hazelton that may have been used for genealogical research by a member of the Hazelton Household. Susan Chisholm Pickard Hazelton's materials in this subseries include her obituary from 1912. Additional information Isaac Hills Hazelton's role in the settlement of estate of Susan Chisholm Pickard Hazelton can be found in his series. The papers in this subseries are arranged by individual and then by type of material.

Photographic Material includes photographs of Mary Young Allen Brewster, William Henry Brewster, Susan Chisholm Pickard Hazelton. There are photographs of various houses associated with Hazelton and Brewster relations. There are also photographs of unidentified relations identified by notations found with the photographs.

Bound Volumes include a photograph album of Hazelton and Brewster ancestors and relatives. The individual photographs are identified in the back of the album. This subseries also includes William Henry Brewster's scrapbook, Mary Young Allen Brewster and Clara L. Hazelton's autograph books and Susan P. Hazelton's Library.

Isaac Hills Hazelton and Mary Allen Brewster Hazelton (1849-1929)

This series is further divided into Biographical Material, Correspondence, Financial Documents, Legal Documents, Printed Material, Artwork, Photographic Material, Bound Volumes, and Artifacts.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Isaac Hills Hazelton was born in Province House Court in Boston on May 17, 1838 to Isaac Hills Hazelton (June 5, 1805-Sept. 8, 1863) and Susan Pickard Hazelton (born February 24th 1814) of Maine. He attended Boston Latin School, entered Harvard with the class of 1860 (left due to his father's illness) and later became an honorary member of the class of 1860. He later graduated from Harvard Medical School. He was appointed Assistant Physician at the New Hampshire Asylum for the Insane in April 1861. He was commissioned Assistant Surgeon in the United States Navy on December 17, 1861, and was ordered to the receiving ship U.S.S. Ohio at the Charlestown Navy Yard. He was ordered to the U.S.S. Vermont January 20, 1862 and remained on the U.S.S. Vermont until January 1, 1863 when he was ordered to the U.S.S. Paul Jones. While onboard the U.S.S. Vermont he was caught in a storm in February 1862 and was presumed dead.

On July 10, 1865 he resigned from the Navy and became Assistant Physician at the McLean Asylum for the Insane on September 11, 1865. After his marriage he conducted a private sanitarium in Milton, practiced Medicine for a few years in Boston, and then moved to Wellesley Hills. In Wellesley the family lived first at 162 Washington Street and then at 319 Washington Street starting in 1884. Isaac Hills Hazelton practiced medicine in Wellesley Hills and also served as the medical examiner. He was an invalid living with his three daughters for at least the last four years of his life. After his death in 1929 he was buried at Mount Auburn Cemetery.

Mary Allen Brewster Hazelton was a descendent of Elder William H. Brewster. She was the daughter of William Henry Brewster and Mary Young Allen (April 15, 1815-1900) of Newburyport where she was raised. She was born on November 26, 1842 and died on December 11, 1923. She married Dr. Isaac Hills Hazelton at the Old North Church in Newburyport in 1867. She had four children with Dr. Isaac Hills Hazelton: Isaac Brewster Hazelton, Margaret Page Hazelton, Mary Brewster Hazelton, and Olivia Bowditch Hazelton.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

Biographical Material consists of the obituaries of Isaac Hills Hazelton from 1929 and Mary Allen Brewster Hazelton from 1923.

Correspondence includes two folders of correspondence from acquaintances to Isaac Hills Hazelton from 1849 to 1923. There is also one folder of correspondence relating to Isaac Hills Hazelton's medical practice. The correspondence is arranged chronologically. There is also one folder of correspondence from Isaac Hills Hazelton to his parents, and three folders of letters between Isaac Hills Hazelton and Mary Allen Brewster Hazelton. The correspondence also includes four folders of correspondence to their children. There are also casebooks from Isaac Hills Hazelton's medical practice. The two larger casebooks can be found in with the bound material in Box 65. These casebooks detail the visits he made during his medical practice between 1884 and 1912.

Financial Documents consist primarily of New England Telephone and Telegraph Company Bills, and requests and receipts for non-profit giving. There is an American Foundation for the Blind Donation Request from 1928 signed by **Helen Keller**.

Legal Documents consists of two folders containing details about Isaac Hills Hazelton's role in the settlement of the Estate of Susan C. Pickard Hazelton and Isaac Hills Hazelton's Life Insurance Policy from Aetna Life Insurance Company dated 1891.

Printed Material includes Isaac Hills Hazelton's Department of the Navy Commissions and Certificates from 1861-1928. This series also includes Mary Allen Brewster Hazelton's American Red Cross Membership Certificates from 1918. There is also a book clipping from *Surgical History in the Rebellion* discussing Isaac Hills Hazelton's naval career and a program from a 1879 production of *H.M.S. Pinafore*, in which Isaac Hills Hazelton performed. In the oversized printed material there is a certificate honoring Isaac Hills Hazelton for his service as Assistant Surgeon in the United States Navy from 1870 and his 1894 Commonwealth of Massachusetts Board of Registration in Medicine Certificate. There is also a Confederate States of America Twenty Dollar Bill and a Confederate States of America One Hundred Dollar Bill both sent to William Henry Brewster and Mary Allen Brewster Hazelton by Isaac Hills Hazelton.

Artwork consists of one Oil painting purchased by Isaac Brewster Hazelton in 1861. The back of the oil painting has pasted on printings of several patriotic poems.

Photographic Material consists of one folder of photographs of Isaac Hills Hazelton and one folder of Mary Allen Brewster Hazelton photographs. Additional photographs of the couple with their grandchild can be found in the Isaac Brewster Hazelton Family Photographic Material folder "Photographs of Extended Family.

Bound Volumes includes Mary Allan Brewster Hazelton's autograph book from 1866.

Artifacts consist of materials from Isaac Hills Hazelton's medical practice.

Isaac Brewster Hazelton Family 1898-1965

COLLECTION NOTE

Olivia Bowditch Hazelton collected the materials in this collection from the Hazelton house in Wellesley. Additional collections of Isaac Brewster Hazelton's papers and paintings may exist at other institutions.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Isaac Brewster Hazelton (1873-1943) was a noted commercial artist and illustrator under the name I.B. Hazelton. He grew up in Wellesley and later moved to Nutley, New Jersey. As a teenager he was a founding member of the Wellesley Drum Corp and was President of the Wellesley High School Class of 1889.

He studied civil engineering and architecture at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (class of 1894) and taught at the Rhode Island School of Design. He illustrated a series of Children's books for E.P. Dutton & Co. Publishers.

His most known work is "Men Wanted for the Army", a recruitment poster first printed in 1914. A lithographic print this work is at the Massachusetts Historical Society (Call #: Bdses-XL 1914). At his death in 1943 his oil paintings hung at Dartmouth College and the New York Massachusetts Institute of Technology Club. He exhibited his paintings in 1906 and 1907 at the Rhode Island School of Design with fellow instructor William C. Loring. He designed a Civil War monument for the rock front of the Wellesley Railroad Station now site of the Wellesley Post Office, which was only sketched as a one-quarter-scale model and never constructed.

Margarita Thompson Hazelton eloped with Isaac Brewster Hazelton in 1906 and they married in Rhode Island. Margarita Thompson Hazleton was born April 14, 1882 in Winchester, Massachusetts and died in 1972 in Norwalk Connecticut. Her parents were William Levi Thompson (born 1859) and Edith Margarita Mead Thompson (born 1856) both of Massachusetts. She had one child, Pricilla Hazelton Davis, with Isaac Brewster Hazelton. The family spent part of each summer with the Hazelton Household in Maine.

Pricilla Hazelton Davis was the model for Isaac Brewster Hazelton's most famous advertisement, the trademark for Clicquot Club Ginger Ale. She was born on October 24, 1907 in Massachusetts and died in August 1994 in Mystic, Connecticut. She married John Clement Davis (1906-1959) the child of Reverend Earl Clement Davis (1876-1953). They had three children Jock Davis, Joy Davis and Jennifer Davis Sawyer (born July 19, 1937). This collection contains limited information about Pricilla Hazelton Davis' children. Jock Davis joined Army Intelligence and spent time in Russia. Jennifer Davis Sawyer married Charles Douglas Sawyer on March 21, 1964 in Rowayton Connecticut. Mary Brewster Hazleton noted Joy Davis' death in her calendar on January 21, 1952.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

Biographic Material section consists of Isaac Brewster Hazelton's extensive obituary from 1943 and Olivia Bowditch Hazelton's notes about his death

Correspondence consists almost entirely of letters written from Isaac Brewster Hazelton to his parents and sisters between 1885 and 1942. There is also a folder of letters from Isaac Brewster Hazelton to Pricilla Hazelton Davis while she was vacationing with the Hazelton Household in Maine and visiting them in Wellesley from 1914 to 1932, and a 1938 letter written to Isaac Brewster Hazelton from Alice Hazelton Green. The letters are arranged by author and then by recipient. There is also one folder of typed readings from Isaac Brewster Hazelton's funeral.

Family Correspondence consists almost completely of letters sent from Isaac Brewster Hazelton Family members to members of the Hazelton Household. The letters are organized by the writer and then by recipient, and ordered chronologically in the folder. The most numerous

letters are those from Pricilla Hazelton Davis to the Hazelton Household. She often refers to her aunts as "little darlings". These letters include requests and appreciation for financial help that were was granted to Pricilla Hazelton Davis by members of the Hazelton Household. There are only two letters from Jock Davis, and no letters from Joy Davis, likely due to her early death. There are a few postcards from Jennifer Davis Sawyer. There is one letter from Anne Scranton to Priscilla Hazelton Davis written in 1956 referencing an accident that Olivia Bowditch Hazelton had, but it is the only letter from a non-family member.

Printed Material is foldered by subject. It includes a photocopy of the Clicquot Club Ginger Ale advertisement as printed in a newspaper, a photocopy of a newspaper article about a 1907 exhibit of Isaac Brewster Hazelton's paintings, a M.I.T. Glee and Banjo Club program from 1895, and his graduation program from the Wellesley High School Class of 1889. There are also copies of printed Christmas Cards of drawings of his family for the years 1912, 1914 and 1918 and a few prints of his artwork. There are also a marriage announcements for Isaac Brewster Hazelton and Margarita Thompson Hazelton from 1906 (even though the couple eloped the night before their planned wedding) and Pricilla Hazelton Davis' wedding to John Clement Davis in 1933.

Artwork consists of sixteen leaves of leaves of undated charcoal drawings and twelve leaves of pen and ink sketches by Isaac Brewster Hazelton. Many of the sketches are clearly for practice as many sketches occupy the same pages. The Wellesley Historical Society also houses his 1896-painting *Portrait of a Young Woman*.

Photographic Material is foldered by subject. There are two folders of photographs of Isaac Brewster Hazelton alone. There are also photographs of Isaac Brewster Hazelton in groups with his Wellesley High School Class, Wellesley Drum Corps members and art school classmates. There is also an unidentified broken group photograph. There is a folder of photographs of the Isaac Brewster Hazelton Family with members of the extended Hazelton Family, and a folder of photographs of Jock Brewster Davies, Joy Brewster Davies, and Jennifer Davis Sawyer. There is a separate folder of photographs of Pricilla Hazelton Davis and a folder of photographs of the Nutley, New Jersey House. There is also a folder of photographs of dogs belonging to the Isaac Brewster Hazelton Family. It is likely that many of these photographs in this subseries were sent to the Hazelton Household through the mail.

Bound Volumes includes a copy of *Chula, Son of the Mound Builders*, a book illustrated by Isaac Brewster Hazelton.

Hazelton Household (1900-1967)

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Mary Brewster Hazelton, Margaret Page Hazelton and Olivia Bowditch Hazelton lived their adult lives at 319 Washington Street in Wellesley. Additional photographs of the house are available in the Wellesley Historical Society's Photographic Material Collection under either the title "Hazelton House" or "Clapp House." The sisters were referred to as the "Misses Hazeltons." Olivia Bowditch Hazleton and Margaret Page Hazelton also combined their finances and additional information about their finances can be found in Olivia Bowditch Hazelton's series. This manuscripts in this series consists of letters sent to the three sisters as collective household and financial documents that referenced the three sisters as a family unit. Isaac Hills Hazelton lived with the sisters until his death in 1929.

ARRANGEMENT NOTE

This series is further divided as follows: Correspondence, Financial Documents, Photographic Material, and Artifacts.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

Correspondence includes letters either addressed to the "Misses Hazeltons" or "Margaret, Olivia and Mary (the order of the sisters' names often changed). This subseries includes Christmas cards and letters from neighbors in Wellesley Hills. Several of the letters convey news of daily family events or information about acquaintances. There are also condolence cards and letters on the 1943 death of Isaac Brewster Hazelton and to Margaret Page Hazelton and Olivia Bowditch Hazelton after the 1953 death of Mary Brewster Hazelton. The sisters also corresponded with a number of servicemen in the United States Naval Reserves during World War Two. A list of these pen pals can be found in Olivia Bowditch Hazelton's handwritten notes. These written relationships continued after the War, the servicemen are identified with the designation USNR in the Box and Folder list. There are also several of letters from Helen Hazelton, which show the relationship between the Hazelton Household and their distant relative. A few of the correspondents in the collection are only identified by their first names, and are identified as Unidentified, [First Name]. Letters from extended family members including Alice Hazelton Green and Clara Hazelton are among the correspondence as are two cards from Olivia Bowditch Hazelton and Margaret Page Hazelton to Mary Brewster Hazelton. There is also a printed copy of a letter the sisters wrote to the editor of the Wellesley Townsman in 1952 about the Civil War Memorial designed by Isaac Brewster Hazelton. The series is foldered by sender and then arranged chronologically.

Financial Documents consists of letters and documents relating to repairs on the family's Cottage on the Isle au Haut, in Maine in 1940 and 1941, and a Wellesley Trust Company Account book for a joint account kept by Olivia and Margaret from 1941 to 1945. There are also receipts from a yearly Christmas gift from the Grace Knight Babson Estate from 1958 to 1964 of between two hundred and three hundred dollars.

Photographic Material consists of photographs of the sisters, photographs sent in correspondence to the Hazelton Household, or photographs of family houses. There are also a number of group photographs with two or more of the sisters and acquaintances. Many of the photographs are identified on the back. There are also photographs of the Hazelton House at 319 Washington Street. There are also a number of photographs of unidentified houses included in letters to the Hazelton Household in this subseries and Photographs of the Maine cottage. There is also a folder containing a photograph contained in a letter from Alice Shelton in 1947. The photographs are foldered by subject matter.

Artifacts include a few household articles such as a small mirror, dress hooks, and sewing materials.

Mary Brewster Hazelton (1880-1953)

ARRANGEMENT

This series is divided into her personal and her Professional life. Her personal life is further divided into the following subseries: Biographical Material, Correspondence, Financial Documents, Legal Documents, Printed Material, Scrapbooks, Photographic Material. The Professional subseries is further divided into Correspondence, Financial Documents, The First Congregational Church of Wellesley Hills Mural Information, Printed Material, Artwork and Artifacts.

LANGUAGE NOTE

A few noted letters in **Correspondence** are in Italian and French. Diaries from 1902 and 1904 contain notes in Italian.

BIOGRAPHICAL MATERIAL

Mary Brewster Hazelton was a distinguished portrait painter. Artistically she is considered part of the Boston School. Reviews of her work in the collection mention her Impressionist style and her use of light sources.

Mary Brewster Hazelton was born in 1868 in Milton Massachusetts and died in 1953 at the Newton-Wellesley Hospital. As a child she was known as "Daisy" often signing artwork and letters with that name through the 1880's. She graduated from Wellesley High School in 1886.

She enrolled at the Museum of Fine Arts Museum School where she studied portrait painting under Edmund Tarbell and worked as an assistant to Philip Hale. After graduating in 1892 she assisted Frank Benson in teaching antique and life drawing classes. In 1893 she was appointed to the assistant instructor of drawing. She received the first Paige Traveling Scholarship from the Museum School in 1899 allowing her to study art for two years in Europe. She later traveled to France with Dr. and Mrs. Calvin Page. In 1896 she received the first Hallgarten Prize for *In a Studio* the best Oil Painting executed in the United States by an American under 35 years of age.

She worked in her studio at the Fenway Studios from 1906 to 1940. According to correspondence in the collection she appears to have suffered from an illness in 1930, which

briefly limited her painting. She suffered a stroke in 1952 and briefly painted with her non-dominant left hand until her death in 1953.

Mary Brewster Hazelton was a charter member of the Guild of Boston Artists and an early member of the Copley Society, the treasurer and one of the founders of the of the Wellesley Society of Artists

SCOPE AND CONTENT

Mary Brewster Hazelton kept her professional correspondence and finances separate from her personal mail, having the professional correspondence and bills sent to her Fenway Studio, most notably during the height of her professional career from 1909 to 1947.

Biographical Material includes her obituaries from 1953, and published Art Biographical Listings.

Correspondence is in Boxes 7-16, and 22-23. Many of the letters are from people whose portraits she painted, neighbors or distant relatives. Some of the letters are from unidentified correspondents or correspondents only identified only by a first name. The letters are foldered by sender and then arranged chronologically within the folder. The majority of the letters are in English. The letters in Italian are from S. Carine, and Gulia Pucci, and the letters in French are from Achille Besnard, Arsène Dupius, Henri Leufiloley, and Eugene Poferillery.

Her most persistent correspondence was with Forrest Knox Libenow (born 1891) a Naval officer. The correspondence in the collection does not indicate how they met, but they spent time together when he was in Boston and he corresponded from assignments around the world, including his time stationed on the U.S.S. Dobbin, U.S.S. Black Hawk, and his assignment as Lt. Commander at the United States Navy Yard on Mare Island in California. He often mailed several letters in one envelope. The correspondence continued his correspondence after his marriage to Louise Braden Colonna daughter of Mrs. Eugene Burford Braden on September 8, 1934. After Mary Brewster Hazelton's death he continued corresponding with Olivia Bowditch Hazelton.

Other notable correspondence is from Isabel Butler, author of *Tales from the Old French*. There is also a large amount of correspondence from Mary Brewster Hazelton's teacher Edmund C. Tarbell, between 1915 and 1937, with the artist Evelyn Purdie, Emily Sargent, Elizabeth Reynolds Child and Elma Gaines Woolworth Russell. There are also letters sent from Mary Brewster Hazelton to immediate family members. The majority of the letters are from 1909-1930. The letters are organized by recipient and then by date. Many of these letters are from her travels to Europe as a young artist, and discuss works of art she encountered.

Correspondence also includes Unbound Notes, Diaries, and Notebooks. Mary Brewster Hazelton often wrote notes on envelopes (dated by their postmarks 1918-1946). There is a folder of poems and quotations copied in her own handwriting, and an informal list of her valuables. All but one of the Diaries is dated. These 56 diaries allowed her to record personal and professional appointments. She often used only a few months in a particular diary and she would often use a diary meant for one year for another year. She kept these calendars during her trips

to Europe between 1899 and 1905. There are a few noted gaps in the diary dates. The first gap is from 1906 to 1910, the second is from 1942-1944 and the third is 1949-1950. Her handwriting in the 1951-1952 Diary shows the effects of the stroke she suffered in 1952. The individual notebooks were often used intermittently and out of order.

Mary Brewster Hazelton often placed pieces of paper, addresses or newspaper articles in her Diaries and Notebooks. These items have been foldered and labeled by the Diary or Notebook in which the material was found and are located in Box 24. There is auxiliary material from Diaries from 1897, 1898, 1900, 1902, 1904, 1920, 1922, 1926, 1928, 1929, 1933, 1934, 1927, 1938, 1941, 1951-1952. The auxiliary material from the notebooks is from 1899, 1903, 1904-1927, 1918, 1919-1940, 1927, 1935, 1937, 1939, 1943, 1944, 1945-1951, and 1946-1947.

Financial Documents consists of Papers sent to Mary Brewster Hazelton's home. In contrast to her sisters, who often combined their financial life, Mary Brewster Hazelton kept the majority of her finances separate from her sisters. The subseries is arranged by organization. Most of her non-profit giving was to artists affected by the World Wars such as the Relief Fund for the Families of French Soldiers, which she supported from 1915-1918. She banked at the First National Bank of Boston. There are three folders of Medical bills from 1910 to 1948. After her death acquaintances gave money to the Newton-Wellesley Hospital.

Legal Documents consists of four folders. They show that she was involved with the settlement of estates for William Henry Brewster and Isabel Butler. This subseries also includes her 1944 Life Insurance Policy, 1944 and correspondence relating to her political support of Herbert Hoover.

Printed Material includes the metal plate for printing her name cards her certificate for her involvement with the American National Red Cross and her library card for the Wellesley Free Library. The majority of the personal printed material consists of newspaper clippings about celebrities, travel and World War I. The majority of the newspapers clippings are from 1930-1936 are organized by subject. There are also art books in Box 68.

Scrapbooks consist of scrapbooks kept by Mary Brewster Hazelton during her European travels and her autograph book. The scrapbooks include book and magazine clippings and pressed flowers. Her autograph book is in Box 68.

Photographic Material contains one folder of photographs of Mary Brewster Hazelton; other items include photographs sent to her in personal correspondence. The photographs are arranged by the person who sent the photograph, not necessarily by the subject. Two tintypes sent by Lucy A. Plympton and Henry Titcomb Page are included in this subseries. Her photograph album is in Box 68.

Professional Correspondence includes letters sent to Mary Brewster Hazelton at her studio. The letters discuss planning sittings, schedules for working on portraits and payments for the portraits during the height of her career. There are fifteen folders of professional correspondence arranged chronologically, and seven folders arranged by subject. The fifteen folders of chronologically arranged professional correspondence is detailed in Appendix B.

The rest of the **Professional Correspondence** is foldered by subject or sender and consists of letters relating to her Portrait of the French military officer Paul Azan, her professional relationship with **John Singer Sargent**, membership in the League of American Artists, Museum of Fine Arts in 1930, teaching at Miss Hill's School and Miss Howe and Miss Marot's School, and correspondence relating to her exhibitions.

Professional Financial Documents includes bills and recipes sent to her studio between 1906 and 1947. These are mainly routine bills such as rent for her Fenway Studio, and bills for drawing materials. There are also receipts Walfred Thulin Frames. The documents also show occasional disputes with the Trustees of the Fenway Studios over the amount of rent due.

First Congregational Church of Wellesley Hills Mural Information consists of seven folders of Papers relating to mural she designed for the Fist Congregational Church of Wellesley Hills in 1912. These materials include photocopies of newspaper articles about the mural, correspondence with contractors, and information about the mural's copyright.

Professional Printed Material includes her membership cards for the American Federation of Arts Membership Cards, Concord Art Association Guild of Boston Artists, and Copley Society of Boston. It also includes collected programs and news clipping about her own exhibits and other artists exhibits. The oversized certificates consist of her First Congregational Church in Wellesley Hills Membership Certificate from 1912, her Hallgarten Prize Certificate from 1896, Panama-Pacific International Honorable Mention from 1901 and her Panama-Pacific International Exposition Bronze Medal from 1915.

Artwork includes Sketchbooks and unbound artwork. The sketchbooks are largely dated and are from 1888-1951. There are notable gaps from 1921-1927, 1928-1937 and 1939-1945. They are arranged chronologically. Materials that she placed in the sketchbooks have been removed and are in Box twenty-four, foldered by their respective sketchbook. There is dated and undated unbound artwork done prior to her trip to Europe with the Paige Travelling Scholarship. The unbound artwork is organized by size and includes pen and ink drawings, pencil sketches and watercolors. [The Wellesley Historical Society also owns fifty-nine of her paintings.]

Artifacts consist of her palette, and travel easel.

Margaret Page Hazelton (1898-1965)

ARRANGEMENT NOTE

This series is divided as follows: Biographical Material, Correspondence, Financial Documents, Printed Material, Artwork, and Photographic Material.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Margaret Page Hazelton was born on March 17, 1876 and died in 1965. She was an active member of the Episcopal Church and a homemaker who designed her garden. She possibly had some training in sketching. She lived at to 319 Washington Street in Wellesley Hills with her two sisters. During her childhood, her family referred to her as Margie. She was the homemaker of the Hazelton Household and did not professional pursue her artistic abilities outside of a hobby. She was an active member of Saint Andrew's Episcopal Church. Based on the materials in the collection her participation in the life of the church appears to increase after 1955. As shown in the collection, she traveled throughout the northeastern United States visiting Episcopal Churches and was an active birder.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

Bibliographic Material consists of Margaret Page Hazelton's obituary from 1965 published in the in the *Wellesley Townsman*. It contains limited information about her life outside of her interest in woodworking. Her funeral was at St. Andrew's Episcopal Church and she was buried at Woodlawn Cemetery in Wellesley. Priscilla Hazelton Davis acted as executor of her estate.

Correspondence includes one folder of letters from 1915 to 1956 arranged chronologically. There is also three folders of correspondence to immediate family members foldered by recipient and then arranged chronologically. The letters to Mary Brewster Hazelton from 1898-1943 discuss household chores and gossip about family friends. Margaret Page Hazelton also discusses attending religious services at Wellesley College and memories of their brother. The letters were sent to Mary Brewster Hazelton while she was away from the Hazelton Household. The four letters to Olivia Bowditch Hazelton between 1905 and 1939 were sent while Olivia was traveling without her sisters. The letters show that Margaret often visited Olivia when she was away from Wellesley for a length of time. The letters to Isaac Hills Hazelton and Mary Allen Brewster Hazelton are from the years 1910 to 1923 and are primarily from Margaret Page Hazelton while she was visiting with Isaac Brewster Hazelton and his family in New York City. There are also three folders of handwritten notes focused on household chores, two birding notebooks and a collection of recipes. Her 1920 notebook contains information about her

attendance at the Conference for Church Work at Wellesley while her 1938 diary contains appointment reminders.

Financial Documents includes copies of her Tax Returns from 1948-1957. In the documents she either left her occupation blank or referred to herself as "retired". The tax returns are arranged chronologically. The 1959-1961 Financial Documents folder includes an uncashed donation to the Trustees of Saint Andrews Church and correspondence relating to her investment in the United Fruit Company and are also arranged chronologically. More information about her finances and how they were intertwined with her sisters' finances can be found in the Hazelton Household and Olivia Bowditch Hazelton series.

Legal Documents consist of a single document from the Estate of Helen L. Winslow in 1962 leaving Margaret Page Hazelton \$500.00.

Printed Material includes nine folders of printed material. They contain her 1951 membership card from the Massachusetts Audubon Society, a 1956 membership certificate from the National Cathedral Association in Washington D.C., brochures from Episcopal Church's, The Magazine and Newspaper clippings focus on antiques and woodworking, There is also a bead bag catalogue. There are also books given to her as a child by relatives, books relating to the Episcopal Church, and a cookbook.

Artwork consists of three folders of sketches in pen and ink, and in pencil. There is also a silhouette, which was exhibited by the Wellesley Historical Society at an unidentified date. The collection also contains her sketchbook kept from 1906 to 1907.

Photographic Material consists of one folder of photographs of Margaret Page Hazelton.

Olivia Bowditch Hazelton (1890-1967)

A few noted letters in the Correspondence are in French.

ARRANGEMENT NOTE

The series is further subdivided into the following sections: Biographical Information, Correspondence, Speeches, Financial Documents, Legal Documents, Printed Material, Scrapbooks and Photographic Material.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Olivia Bowditch Hazelton was born on January 26, 1873 in Milton, Massachusetts and died on March 15, 1967 at the age of ninety-four at the Newton-Wellesley Hospital. She moved to Wellesley at the age of three. She was a noted expert on the importance of music in the kindergarten. She was named after a friend of her parents, Olivia Yardley Bowditch. The last three years of her life were spent at the Sudbury Pines Nursing Home.

As a teenager she served as the Secretary of the Wellesley High School Class of 1890. She attended the Kindergarten Training School (a precursor to Wheelock College) under Lucy Wheelock graduating in 1899. She also took graduate courses in education with Miss Laura Fisher and advanced courses in music at Boston University, Harvard University and the Summer School of Musical Art in New York.

She opened the first kindergarten in Wellesley in a house on Cedar Street around 1900 and was the was the Director of Music in the Wheelock School, Miss Niel's Training. School and Mrs. Merl R. Wolfard's School. She retired from the Francis Parkman School District in 1943 having worked in the kindergartens in various schools including the Walk Hill Street School and the Edwin P. Seaver School, often under the supervision of Juliette Billings. She also was a frequent lecturer on the importance of music education in Kindergarten.

Items in the collection show that her personal and professional life were intertwined and many of her close friends were also colleagues and/or fellow singers at the First Congregational Church of Wellesley Hills, or fellow descendants of the Elder William H. Brewster of the Mayflower Colony. Letters and scrapbooks in the collection show that she was known for wearing hats.

The number of pictures of her cat Peter in the photographic materials subseries shows that he was an important part of her life.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

Biographical Material consists of one 1967 obituary mainly discussing her interest in genealogy and her career in music in the kindergarten.

Correspondence consists mainly of letters from colleagues or Wellesley neighbors. The authors of many letters are unidentified or only identified by a first name. The identity of all authors has been attempted. Her most frequent was from Grace Conant, Juliette Billings, Irma Clapp, and Assistant professor of music at Harvard William C. Heilman, Evelyn Carter Giles, Wellesley doctor W.L. Macdonald, Ray Prescott, Mary C. Shute, Sarah Wallace, Music Professor Horace Whitehouse, and Anne Scranton. The letters from Eugene Kenefick and the Kerambrun Family are in French. The correspondence is foldered by sender and then arranged chronologically. There is a small amount of professional correspondence, primarily cards celebrating her 1943 retirement. Also included are letters to her sister and parents. The letters are arranged by recipient and then arranged chronologically.

The unbound notes are organized by subject and include her notes on grades given to students, thoughts on Music Theory, and a list of the United States Naval Reserve members with whom the Hazelton Household corresponded. The letters from the United States Navel Reserve men can be found in the Hazelton Household series. There are eleven diaries recording appointment spanning the years 1884 to 1945. She often only used a diary for a few months or reused an old diary. Four of the diaries are from the years 1884 to 1898 and five of the diaries are from the years 1930 to 1935. The diary entries are not comprehensive and contain appointment reminders. Many of her notebooks are undated, and it appears that she often used the same notebook sporadically and non-exclusively for several years. While there are gaps in the dated material from 1934-1940 and 1942-1950, it is likely that notes from these years can be found in the undated material. A notebook from 1957 contains information about who had Mary Brewster Hazelton Paintings, and she also received the typed notes of Juliette Billings. The notebooks are arranged chronologically when possible.

Speeches include extensive notes for Olivia Bowditch Hazelton's lectures on the importance of music in the kindergarten. These notes are organized by speech or topic.

Financial Documents consist mainly of household bills. They show that Olivia Bowditch Hazelton and Margaret Page Hazelton's financial lives were intertwined while Mary Brewster Hazelton kept her finances separate from her sisters. There is a folder of receipts showing support of the Laura Fisher Taussig Memorial Fund, named after one of her teachers. There are also six folders of tax return copies years 1945 to 1960 and a folder of handwritten notes about her finances, most of them pricing desired purchases.

Legal Documents contain documents related to legacies left to Olivia Bowditch Hazelton. There is information on the William Henry Brewster Trust from 1929, the Harriet Anna Niel Estate in 1945. There is also a folder of information about legacies left to her in other Estates between 1929-1955, which includes information about estate of Irma Clapp White, estate of Ellen Gray,

Brewster Trust, Pension, Estate of Clara Frothingham Wadleigh, and the Estate of Isaac Hills Hazelton.

Printed Materials contains certificates for completed educational programs. There are also a few musical performance programs and newspaper clippings about education. The oversize printed material includes her 1899 Kindergarten Training Class Diploma Signed by Lucy Wheelock, her 1890 Wellesley High School Diploma and her 1907 Certificate for Completion of a Course in Public School Music from the New School of Methods in Public School Music from 1907. There are also a number of children's books given to her by relatives.

Scrapbooks include three scrapbooks dated 1943 from students and faculty members of the Francis Parkman School District commemorating her career in Kindergarten Music. There is also a folder of a Kindergarten arts and crafts project.

Photographic Material includes a folder of photographs of Olivia Bowditch Hazelton alone. There are also photographs of her with friends, with her cat Peter and Photographs of former kindergarten class. There are also photographs that were included in correspondence. All photographs have been organized by subject or sender.

ARRANGEMENT NOTE

This series is further divided as follows: Acquisition, Inventory, Exhibition, Collection Research, Individual Painting Research, Photographic Material of Paintings, Unidentified Photographic Material and Prints.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

Acquisition includes notes about the acquisition of Hazelton paintings, artifacts and papers by the Wellesley Historical Society. Also included are a copy of Isaac Brewster Hazelton Painting Label from the Wellesley Historical Society, and information about Helen Hazelton's estate gifts to the Wellesley Historical Society.

Inventory includes information about various times the collection has been inventories. These notes include a 1972 Collection Inventory, an undated Partial Inventory of Mary Brewster Hazelton's Professional Correspondence, Portrait Identification Notes, from 1991 and a Partial Inventory of oversize certificates from the collection.

Exhibition includes information about various exhibits of the collection and related paintings. The largest of these exhibits was a two-part exhibit in 1996 and 1997. The first part of the exhibit was entitled *A Exhibition of Portraits* and the second part *The Artist's Versatility*. There was also a small exhibit from the collection in 2010-2011. The information in this subseries is foldered by exhibit, and is not complete.

Collection Research includes an excerpt from a 1980 thesis on The Guild of Boston Artists, Mary Brewster Hazelton's Pedigree Chart and information printed from the online database *Ask Art* (www.askart.com) used in the preparation of this finding aid.

Individual Painting Research consists of information primarily collected during a 1990 attempt by the Wellesley Historical Society to produce a Catalogue Raisoné of Mary Brewster Hazelton's works. A form was sent out to art dealers and individuals asking them to send information and photographs of known works to the Wellesley Historical Society. The titles of paintings used by the respondents are the ones used in this finding aid. The information is generally foldered by individual painting.
