### **Biographical Note**

The Hewins' House, located at 167 Forest Street, Wellesley Massachusetts was built by Dr. Parke Woodbury Hewins between 1905 and 1906. Hewins lived in the house with his wife, Jesse Warner Hewins and their daughter Elizabeth Hewins. Dr. Hewins practiced medicine for a short time before joining his brother in the real estate business. On Sunday February 4, 1928, Dr. Hewins passed away in Wellesley. He was survived by his wife and daughter. Ownership of the house passed to Elizabeth Hewins. Born on August 24, 1896 Elizabeth Hewins was a teacher at the Windsor School in Boston. She was known for making generous donations to various charities and never married. After Elizabeth Hewins' death on March 19, 1987, the house and 7 acres of land, which was located between Wellesley Avenue and Forest Street, was sold to developers. The developers created 15 lots, on one of which the original Hewins' House remained. The house was renovated as part of the project and is now 5 Hewins Farm Rd.

### **Scope and Content Note**

This collection contains photographs found at the Hewins Estate. The collection is mainly comprised of photographs of several different families. Families included are: Congdon, Grant, Greeley, Gregg, Hussey, Neville, Pratt, Richardson, Rowland, & Thomas families.
