Biographical Note

L. Linder Lombard was born Lydia Linder Grevatt on February 23, 1909 to parents Henry T. Grevatt and Elizabeth L. Smith Gravatt. The family lived in West Newton and Lydia attended Dana Hall School in Wellesley. Following her father's death in 1934, her mother Elizabeth purchased land and built a house at 26 Woodridge Road in Wellesley. Before her marriage, Lydia Linder Grevatt served as the Air Raid Warden for the town of Wellesley during WWII. Lydia married Edward Whitter Lombard on November 4, 1950. The couple stayed in Wellesley, living near Babson College in Wellesley Hills. Following Elizabeth Grevatt's death in December 1959 the Lombards moved into the house at 26 Woodridge Road. Edward Lombard died on June 11, 1986 and L. Linder Lombard died on October 27, 2002.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains materials related to L. Linder Lombard's involvement in Wellesley civil defense activities during WWII. Of note are the materials related to the specific role of air raid warden.
