### **Biographical Note**

Margaret Stuart Urann was born May 17, 1902 in Chelsea Massachusetts to parents Bertha (Pickford) and Warren Urann. Before moving to Wellesley, Massachusetts she lived and attended school in Lexington, Massachusetts (1908), Prattville School in Chelsea, Massachusetts (1909), Sullivan Harbor, Maine (1910), and Hudson, New Hampshire (1911). Her family moved to Wellesley in 1914 and she attended Wellesley Public Schools. Her high school education was split between Wellesley Public Schools and Northfield School for Girls, as known as Northfield Seminary for Young Ladies. Before attending college, Urann worked for a period of time in the bookkeeping department of Babson's Reports in Wellesley, Massachusetts. She attended Boston University School of Religious Education and Social Services, graduating as a member of the Class of 1927 with a degree in Social Work. In addition to her degree, she was named the 1927 Class Poet upon graduation.

Following her college graduation, Urann worked as a Child Welfare Agent for the state of Connecticut, in New Haven. After eighteen months in Connecticut, Urann returned to Boston University with the intention of studying for a Master's Degree in writing. When the Great Depression struck in 1929, she returned home to Wellesley and began working at the Townsman, published by the Wellesley Press. Urann worked as a proofreader until 1946 when she moved to the editorial staff. Urann would continue to work at the Townsman until 1972 when she retired. Both before and after her retirement at the Townsman, Urann's contributions were not limited to

her editorial duties. Urann researched and wrote many articles which were published in the Townsman. These articles mainly addressed either religion or history.

In addition to her work at the Townsman, Urann was active in the community. Upon moving to Wellesley, the Urann family were members of the Village Congregational Church and later, the Hills Congregational Church. In 1969 they joined the Wellesley Baptist Church and Urann served as the church's benevolence treasure for approximately twenty years. In this role she was responsible for managing the church's monetary donations to both domestic and foreign missionary work. When her eye sight became so poor that she had to give up that post, she was asked to start the Senior Citizen Bible Study class at the Wellesley Baptist Church.

Margaret Urann was active in other areas of the community as well. She was a member of the Wellesley Chapter of the National League of American Pen Women, the Wellesley Poetry Club, The Boston Manuscript Club, The New England Women's Press Association, The Boston Cosmopolitan Club, the Salvation Army, and the Wellesley Historical Society.

Urann was active in reorganizing the Wellesley Historical Society in 1953 and held several leadership positions within the organization, including serving as a Board Member and Correspondence Secretary. She put her writing skills to work for a number of Historical Society projects including "Four Tours of Historical Wellesley" (1968 & 1971), and Historical Society Calendars from 1979 – 1982. As part of the Town Centennial, she was commissioned by the Townsman to write two feature historical articles in 1981. She also wrote a historical sketch in blank verse depicting eras of town history from 1636 – 1881; this sketch was produced as a play by the Historical Society in 1982.

In addition to her historical writing, Urann wrote a memoir of her time spent in Maine as a ten year old girl titled "Maggie's Journal" as well as number of short stories and a collection of over 500 poems. A number of these poems were published in the Townsman.

Urann's work within the community garnered her a number of awards over the course of her life. In 1975 she was named town historian during the official ceremony recognizing the Town of Wellesley as a National Bicentennial Community. Other awards and honors include a Wellesley Chamber of Commerce citation for community service; a national citation for historical research presented by the Amos Mills Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution; the emblem plaque from the Salvation Army, recognizing her service as secretary for more than 25 years; and an award from the Wellesley Historical Society for more than 30 years of volunteer service. She was also chosen honorary Grand Marshal of the Wellesley Veterans Parade in 1974, the first woman to be chosen for this honor.

Urann passed away at the age of 91 at her Wellesley home on November 14, 1994. She was unmarried and had no children. Her known addresses in Wellesley include 60 Central Street, Atwood Street, 44 Curve Street, 70 Curve Street, Overlook Drive.

### **Scope and Content Note**

This collection documents the life and work of Margaret S. Urann as well as the history of the town of Wellesley.

The collection documents Urann's life through materials such as newspaper clippings; her family genealogy; personal timelines recording her schooling, professional life, and personal events; notebooks, diaries, and calendars; correspondence; and photographs.

The history of the town of Wellesley is also documented through Urann's collection of records relating to the clubs and organizations in which she was an active member, including the Wellesley Historical Society. In addition to the history provided by the club and organizational records, the collection contains Urann's extensive collection of historical research regarding the Town of Wellesley. This research is mainly composed of Urann's personal notes and collection of relevant newspaper clippings.

This collection also contains a large number of Urann's poems and other creative writings.
