Biographical Note

Allen Parker Moulton Sr. was born in Wellesley on July 11, 1895 to parents Willard H. Moulton and Ada Fuller Moulton. Moulton grew up at 100 Wellesley Avenue and attended Wellesley public schools. He served during World War I in the 302d Regiment of the U.S. Army, stationed at Fort Devens located in Devens, Massachusetts. Moulton married Beryl Ethelyn Kimball in November 1917. Following his release from the army, Moulton and his wife made their home at 84 Seaver Street, Wellesley Massachusetts where they raised their two sons and two daughters. Moulton owned his own plumbing and heating business, served as a member of Wellesley's Auxiliary Police Force, and was active in the Wellesley Post of the American Legion. He died in Wellesley on April 2, 1943 and is buried in Woodlawn Cemetery in Wellesley.
