Historical Note

The national Veterans of Foreign Wars organization was founded by veterans of the Spanish-American War (1898) and the Philippine Insurrection (1899 – 1902). Initially, it was formed in local chapters, with a focus on mutual aid and support, but developed into state societies and then a national aid society.

The Wellesley VFW Post 5190 is no longer extant.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains two scrapbooks documenting activities of VFW, Wellesley Post 5190 and Auxiliary. One scrapbook documents Post and Auxiliary activities from 1954 – 1955. The other documents only Post activities, 1962-1963. The scrapbooks generally contain photographs, newspaper clippings, programs, correspondence, memorials/obituaries, and event planning.
