# **Historical Note**

The Wellesley Cooperative Clothing Exchange "began in 1945 during World War II as the result of the difficulty in obtaining good, new clothing for children. It was started by a group of cooperative-minded faculty wives at Wellesley College, headed by Esther Houghton (Mrs. Walter Houghton). Although the first sales were limited to children's clothing, it soon became necessary to add men's and women's by popular demand" (*A History 1945-1977*, in collection).

The sale has been held in many venues throughout town during its operation, but settled on Wellesley College and then Mass Bay Community College. There was what was called "The Sale" (in August), as well as a smaller Spring (March) Sale.

The Exchange was completely staffed by volunteers; by the mid-1990s the event was selling approximately 25,000 items of clothing, with the help of 250 volunteers (*The Wellesley Townsman*, July 28, 2005, p. 1). Volunteers fell into three categories, and wore corresponding colored aprons during the bi-annual sale events: Pink, Green, and Blue. Pink Smocks were General Committee, Green Smocks were Departmental Committees, and the Blue Smocks were floor workers at the sales.

By 1995 the Exchange counted over 500 Wellesley families who submitted clothing, with thousands coming to the event to buy. "The Wellesley Cooperative Clothing Exchange for fifty

years [1995] has been a kind of folk festival, a celebration of friendship, and an honored town tradition" (*A Fiftieth Anniversary Celebration—1995*, in collection).

The Exchange dissolved in 2006. Over the years it had used profits to fund scholarships for Wellesley students; since dissolution, those funds have been administered by the Wellesley Scholarship Foundation.

#### **Scope and Content Note**

This collection contains papers and items relating to the operations of the Wellesley Cooperative Clothing Exchange. Much of the operations were geared toward mobilizing a large staff of volunteers to run the sales.
