Historical Note

The Wellesley Garden Club was founded in 1929; it is the oldest garden club in Wellesley, and one of the oldest in the country in continuous operation. Their focus is on the science of horticulture and the art of gardening, with the goal of "the advancement of gardening, the development of home grounds, and further beautification of the town" (Bylaws).

The club is still extant, and members participate in a number of area horticultural events including the Museum of Fine Arts "Art in Bloom" annual show, as well as a "Mini Art in Bloom" event at the Wellesley Community Center.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains materials almost entirely related to the business of the Wellesley Garden Club Membership Committee. The bulk of the collection consists of membership applications and supporting application correspondence, as well as other correspondence, from 1981 to 1998. The collection also contains three notebooks containing membership committee work within the context of executive board business. There is also a box of index card records which acted as a membership database; the cards mostly date from the 1970s into the 1980s, but the box also contains legacy records going back to the 1940s.

System of Arrangement

The collection is organized into four series. Materials in Series I have been ordered by membership application year, though many materials accompanying the applications pre- and post- date the actual application date; they include reference and recommendation letters. Materials in Series II have been organized by year, and by month within each folder; there are two folders of undated correspondence, and two folders of "change in status" correspondence which are unsorted. The Series III special box of membership index cards has been left in the order in which it was donated, with blank cards and dividers removed. Series IV contains ephemera: one photograph, several name badges, and three membership booklets.
