Biographical Note

Henry Dana White was born on October 29, 1898 in Brookline, Massachusetts to parents Katherine Dana and William Howard White. Along with his siblings Katherine H. White and Robert W. White, Henry White was educated in the Wellesley Public Schools, graduating in 1917. Henry White graduated from Harvard University in 1921 and went on to graduate from Harvard Law in 1924. He worked as a self-employed lawyer in Boston for 55 years, retiring at the age of 79. During World War II he served in the U.S. Army.

A resident of 30 Cliff Road in Wellesley, White was an active member of the community. He served as a town meeting member from 1937 – 1979 and was a member of the Wellesley Hills Congregational Church, serving as Sunday School Superintendent for several years. His most notable contribution to the Wellesley community was the 55 years he served as scoutmaster of Wellesley Boy Scout Troop 182 (previously known as Troop 2W). In 1976 he was recognized as Scoutmaster of the Year for his contributions to scouting.

White died on February 25th, 1979 at the age of 80 and is interred in Mount Auburn Cemetery.

Scope and Content Note

This series contains materials related to the life and work of Henry D. White. The bulk of the collection is made of up correspondence belonging to White. Other materials of note include

items regarding his time spent at Harvard, his career as a lawyer, and his involvement with the Boy Scouts. Also included are materials related to the town of Wellesley including, Town Meeting resources, information about Wellesley High School, and the First Congregational Church of Wellesley Hills.
